FamilySearch is the family history site of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS). It offers free access to the world's largest family history collection (4+ billion searchable names). The records, resources and services available include:

- Worldwide records that have been gathered, preserved and shared on microform or online
- Worldwide Historical Record Collections (2274+ and growing) with many linked to online digital images of the original record (most free).

Note: From 13 Dec 2017 you need to log in with a free FamilySearch Account to use FamilySearch.
